Air Emissions Management Policy

Cosmo First Limited ('the Company') is committed to delivering our sustainability vision by establishing this policy to demonstrate our dedication to preventing, abating, and mitigating polluting emissions to the air. In furtherance of this commitment, the Company has adopted this 'Air Emissions Management Policy.'

Background

Many industrial processes generate a wide variety of polluting emissions into the air. Some of these emissions, such as carbon dioxide and methane, are directly linked to the global issue of climate change, while others, like smoke, dust, and fumes, can contribute to local environmental problems. However, specific polluting emissions to the air, such as sulphur dioxide, nitrogen oxides, persistent organic pollutants (POPs), volatile organic compounds (VOCs), hazardous air pollutants (HAPs), etc., are responsible for a range of national and regional impacts, including acid rain, damage to the ozone layer and chronic human health issues, necessitating effective management. Entities should disclose any contextual information necessary to understand how the Air Emissions data has been compiled, including any standards, methodologies, assumptions, and/or calculation tools used.

Policy

We aim to gain a full and detailed understanding of the size and nature of all our polluting air emissions. To do this, we will:

- Comply with the National Ambient air quality standards.
- Undertake a rigorous independent assessment of all the air emissions on specific intervals from all our sites to determine where those emissions come from.
- Evaluate the potential pollutants that each air emission may contain.
- Assess all treatment and abatement mechanisms employed at our sites, including an evaluation of their effectiveness at removing pollutants.

Develop programs to:

- Prevent or minimize the creation of air emissions in the first place through improved efficiency, the use of new technologies, and changes in processes.
- Identify any adverse impacts associated with our air emissions and seek to mitigate these wherever possible.

Monitor, on a regular basis, both the quantities of air emissions we produce and the quantities of any pollutants within those air emissions to see how we are progressing, reporting on this progress to our stakeholders.

We aim to continue our current efforts to prevent or minimize the amount of polluting air emissions we produce. To do this, we will continue to:

- Exploit existing opportunities to prevent and minimize the creation of polluting air emissions on our sites.

- Educate our employees about the causes and impacts of polluting air emissions so they can, with our help, minimize their own impacts.
- We prohibit the use of any new HCFCs or HFCs* within any of our plants. Where such gases continue to be used in old equipment, this equipment will be closely monitored for leakages and the replacement of the equipment will be prioritised.

We will continue to be fully committed to our statutory and voluntary obligations relating to air emissions.

This Policy Shall be communicated to all employees including contract workmen.

General

This policy will be reviewed and amended as and when required by the ESG Committee. This Policy would be subject to modification in accordance with the guidelines / clarifications as may be issued from time to time by relevant statutory and regulatory authority. The Committee may modify, add, delete, or amend any of the provisions of this Policy.
